

What does this course include?

The course was put together by a team of experts from the General Commission on United Methodist Men, the General Board of Discipleship, and Man in the Mirror. It is based upon the 18-hour No Man Left Behind Conference developed by Man in the Mirror.

The course consists of four, 3-hour units. It can be presented in four weekly sessions, two Saturday sessions or as a weekend training event.

This course is endorsed by the General Commission on United Methodist Men (GCUMM) and the General Board of Discipleship (GBOD). This non-denominational course is strongly influenced by Wesleyan Theology.

- (3) The 5-count Class Pack-contains 5 sets of books and workbooks, plus the CD.



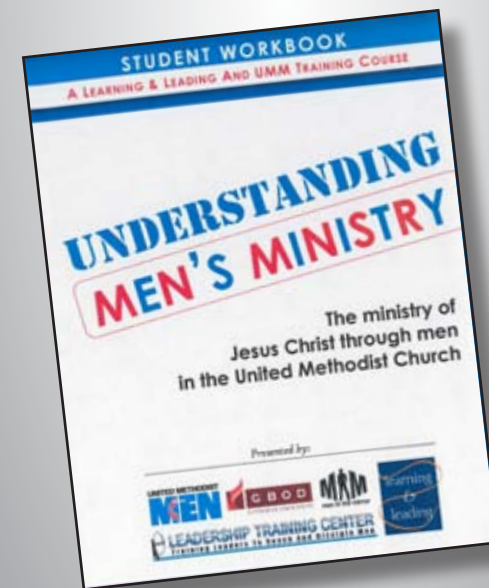

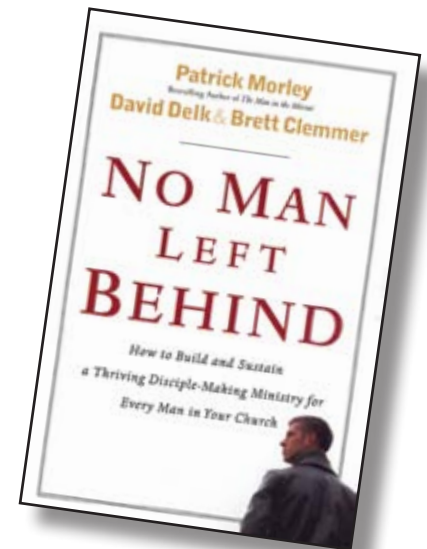

What is this course about?

The course is based upon *No Man Left Behind* (NMLB). The content includes:

- The process of men moving through stages in their Christian journey.
- The three organizational pillars needed to support the ministry model.
- The creation of a customized vision for the men in your church and creation of a plan of action.
- A create-capture-sustain engine to drive the ministry.
- Background material that integrates the Model and explains how to attract non-Christian men into the church and move them along into discipleship.
